Fujichem Sonneborn Limited (FCS) is fully committed to safeguarding the health, safety, and welfare of its employees, contractors, and visitors.


We recognise that robust safety management not only enhances the well-being of our workforce but also contributes to the efficiency and profitability of our operations.
